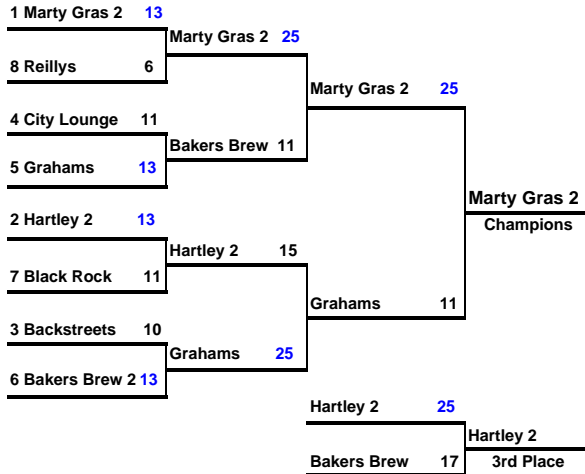


2008 Arlington Dart League Championship Playoffs

Playoff Notes:

Only qualified players can participate playoff matches. (10 weeks)
 Qualified players are marked with an X in the teamstats file.
 The first round is to 13 points. Higher seeds have home field.
The highest rated teams will play the lowest seeded teams to advance after each round.
 The second and third round matches are to 25 points.
 The first team to score 25 pts. over 2 weeks will advance to the next round.
 The higher seeded team will have the choice of playing home the 1st week.*
 The second match will be played in the opposite location.
 In the event of a 24-24 tie, each team will pick two players and a one game, sudden death match will be played. (2B Cricket)
 A tie in the Championship game will be best 2 out of 3.
 A restricted player can only play if both teams use them for the tie breaker.
 Restricted =(A ranked players in B division, B ranked players in C division.)
 Higher ranked team gets choice for bull. Winner of bull starts.
 All games must be completed to receive prize money.

*Based on availability of boards for bars that have more than one team.

The top 2 teams in each division, determined by points, clinch a playoff spot. (2 from Division 1, and 2 from Division 2) The next 4 teams, also by points, will secure the 5th through 8th spots regardless of what division they play in. They can be from the same division so there may be a case where 6 teams from one division and only 2 teams from the other division are in the playoffs.

Each playoff team will be seeded by total points from #1 to #8.
 Ties in the rankings will be determined by, in order of: Most wins, Least losses, Record vs. each other, Total points vs. each other and if necessary, a coin flip.
